#### A Note From Jeremy

My dad recently asked us if we would like some old postcards he acquired, written and sent between my grandmother and greatgrandmother. He explained that many of them were faded and difficult to read. I told him we would gladly take them and see if we could decipher what they said.

My dad went on to explain the importance of the postcards in his mother's life. When my grandmother moved away from home as a young woman, she would send a postcard to her mother every week. My greatgrandmother would then send a postcard back to her. In the days before email and cell phones, this was a vitally important practice that allowed grandmother to keep tabs on the health of her mother. If postcards stopped coming from great-grandmother, my grandmother knew something was wrong or that her mother was sick, and she would go visit her.

As my dad explained this to me, it reminded me how vitally important it is that we don't become so embroiled in the digital world that we fail to leave these important keepsakes behind when we are gone. What will happen to your digital photos hundreds of years from now? If you never send a greeting card or postcard to a loved one, how will our descendants gain insight into our lives? If all of your social interaction is limited to social media, is there a permanent record somewhere that your descendants will be able to look at and learn more about you and your family?

The digital age is fantastic. It allows us to remain in contact with each other in ways our ancestors could never have imagined. But with this impressive technology comes the danger of losing our footprint on the world for future generations to discover and learn from.

Next time you back up your photos, pick out a few of the best ones and have them printed at your local drugstore. Reconsider only sending a Facebook "happy birthday" to your close relatives; send them a greeting card instead, including a hand-written note. Keep a hand-written journal that you can pass on to your children to give them a glimpse into your life.

In this digital world, it is more important than ever to take specific steps to ensure our family history is available to future generations in tangible ways, rather than being lost in "the cloud" forever.
