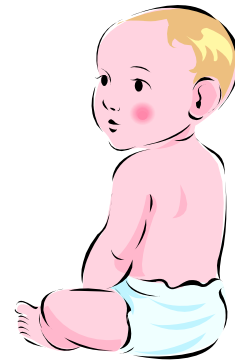
RV hook-ups are available for anyone who is interested, but need to be reserved early.

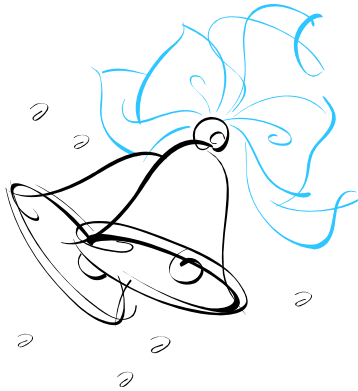

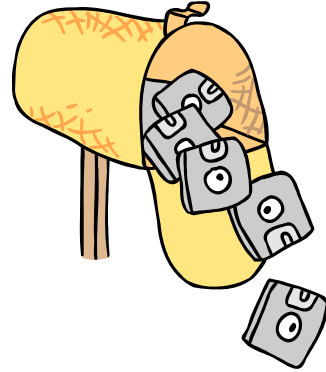
The Family on the Web
